

## Zero Mask Mounting Instructions

Boulder Hockey Shield Zero mask mounting instructions and Infinity chin cup adjustment.

Note: You'll need to skate few times before your eyes fully track through the media of the lens.

Cleaning: Clean the lens use a drop or two of dish liquid on wet sponge. Wet lens clean and rinse thoroughly. Towel dry. The combination anti-fog coating and scratch resistant coatings both sides of the lens and the mask design with convection airflow will give you a beautiful fog-free view of hockey. Keep mask outside bag to dry after use.

Helmets and mask circumference. If you find the mask circumference is too narrow or too wide you can open the upper width of the mask which is 8" and close or open to fit the helmet and J-bars. Remove the lens and pull or squeeze the mask to the helmet width. The mask will stay in that shape. Reattached the lens but don't over tighten. Make sure the side cushions are in place.

### Description

1. 3/8" stainless screws included and J-bars

Mounting clips face up. Screws included fit into the posts inside the front of the helmet.

2. Snap buckle affixes to the male posts on both sides of the helmet.



Adjustment buckle loop around outside cage frame bar, then strap snaps to side of helmet with snap buckle.



Chin cup attached to lower vertical bars. Left picture chin cup attached to vertical bars. Picture 2, chin cup is floating.

Note: Both methods the adjustment buckle attaches to outside cage frame edge for proper fit.
